ISLAMABAD, 13 Jan (Bernama-UNA) -- Kesatuan Agensi Berita Pertubuhan Kerjasama Islam (UNA) dan Liga Dunia Islam (MWL) telah menandatangani memorandum kerjasama pada Ahad, bertujuan melancarkan kempen media bagi meningkatkan kesedaran tentang hak kanak-kanak perempuan untuk mendapatkan akses kepada pendidikan, lapor UNA.

Memorandum itu juga antara lain bertujuan untuk menyelaraskan usaha antara kedua pihak dalam mengukuhkan tindakan bersama antara agensi-agensi berita dan saluran media di negara-negara Islam mengenai isu berkenaan.

Majlis menandatangani memorandum itu berlangsung semasa persidangan global bertajuk "Pendidikan Kanak-Kanak Perempuan dalam Komuniti Muslim: Cabaran dan Peluang," yang dianjurkan oleh kerajaan Pakistan dan diselenggarakan oleh MWL di Islamabad, dengan penyertaan luas daripada organisasi serantau dan antarabangsa.

UNA diwakili Ketua Pengarahnya Mohammed Abd Rabbo Al-Yami, manakala MWL diwakili oleh Kaunselor Abdul Karim Bakhsh.

Memorandum ini adalah sebahagian daripada platform perkongsian antarabangsa yang dilancarkan oleh persidangan "Pendidikan Kanak-Kanak Perempuan dalam Komuniti Muslim," bertujuan untuk mentransformasikan hasil persidangan menjadi inisiatif praktikal dan projek-projek konkrit untuk menyokong pendidikan wanita dan kanak-kanak perempuan.

Nancy: Socso contributions serve as 'insurance' amid untimely death

KUCHING: Social Security Organisation (Socso) contributions can serve as a form of 'insurance' to a household in the event of an untimely death of a family member.

In stating this, Minister of Women, Family and Community Development Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri encouraged the public—employed or unemployed—to contribute to Socso.

"For example, the case involving the family of the late Nurul Asikin Lan; it is crucial that people understand the benefits of contributing to Socso.

"As Nurul Asikin contributed to Socso, her parents are able to receive the benefit," the Santubong MP told reporters when met after visiting the bereaved family at their residence in Darul Hana here yesterday.

Following Nurul Asikin's death due to an alleged murder last month, Socso provided a funeral

benefit of RM3,000 and a lifetime monthly survivors' pension of RM608 for her parents.

In addition to the financial support, Socso also presented the family with a 'Kotak Prihatin' containing daily necessities to further assist them.

The visit, Nancy said, underscores the government's

commitment to supporting families in their time of need, while raising awareness about the crucial role of Socso in providing a safety net for the families of contributors.

Moreover, she assured the family that her ministry will provide counselling support.

"We can visibly see that Nurul

Asikin's mother is still in a state of trauma. We shall observe first, and if the trauma persists, we are ready to provide emotional assistance," she said.

Among those present were Socso Sarawak director Tan Phang Chia and Nurul Asikin's parents Lan Endor and Nasib Kantok.

kaunseling kepada keluarga Nurul Ashikin jika diperlukan.

Bagaimanapun, beliau ber-

kata kementerian masih belum menerima permintaan untuk perkhidmatan tersebut.

"Kita boleh lihat ibu mangsa masih trauma dan susulan itu, kita perlu memberi mereka masa sehingga mereka

bersedia.

"Kita akan memerhatikan dahulu dan akan terus memantau, melainkan mereka bersedia untuk menerima bantuan lanjut."

"Kita sentiasa terbuka dan tidak mahu menekan keluarga yang masih trauma dengan kejadian itu," tambahnya.

Lawatan Nancy itu menekankan komitmen kerajaan untuk menyokong keluarga pada masa mereka memerlukan, di samping meningkatkan kesedaran tentang peranan penting PERKESO dalam menyediakan jaringan keselamatan untuk pencarum dan keluarga mereka.

Pengarah PERKESO Sarawak Tan Phang Chia turut hadir dan menyampaikan cek serta sumbangan kepada ibu bapa Nurul Asikin.

Family cries for justice for murdered Nurul Asikin

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KUCHING: "I want him dead," sobbed Nasib Kantok, 60, as she broke down in tears, demanding justice for her daughter Nurul Asikin Lan who was murdered last month.

Overwhelmed with grief, Nasib clung to her husband Lan Endor, 53, who silently consoled her when speaking to reporters at their home, during a visit by Minister of Women, Family and Community Development Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri yesterday.

Lan described Nurul Asikin, 28, as "a bright and cheerful young woman, who was always considerate of her family".

"She would always tell her mother whenever she went out

with her friends," he said.

Recalling the events leading up to her disappearance, Lan said Nurul Asikin had gone out for dinner on Dec 5 but never returned home.

"Her mother called her around 4am the next day, but there was no answer. I tried calling too, but she didn't pick up."

Subsequently, the family reported her missing to the police when their attempts to reach her failed.

Days later, the family's worst fears were confirmed when their niece informed them that Nurul Asikin's body had been found.

"I had to go to the mortuary to identify her body; it was difficult to identify her," recounted Lan.

However, in facing their grief, the family expressed their gratitude to the government and community for their support.

"We've come to terms with the incident, and we have

accepted what has happened," he said.

A 23-year-old e-hailing driver, Zakwan Mokhtar, was charged in the Magistrates' Court here last month with the murder of Nurul Asikin.

No plea was taken as the case is to be transferred to the High Court, with the lower court fixing Feb 10 for further mention.

Nurul Asikin's decomposed body was found by the public in a ditch at Jalan Setia Raja here on Dec 14.

The discovery led to the accused's arrest on the same day.

Sarawak Police Commissioner Datuk Mancha Ata was previously reported as saying that the accused is believed to have asked for Nurul Asikin's jewellery, namely a gold bracelet and gold earrings, because he wanted to pawn them to fund a trip to Cambodia to watch a football match.

Kuskop aims for 30 pct increase in women entrepreneurs in MSMEs

KOTA BHARU: The Ministry of Entrepreneur and Cooperatives Development (Kuskop) has set a target to increase the number of women entrepreneurs in the micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) sector by at least 30 per cent this year.

Deputy Secretary-General (Policy and Monitoring) Noor Afifah Abdul Razak said there are 1.1 million MSME entrepreneurs nationwide at present, but only 230,000 of them are women

actively engaged in agriculture, services, and manufacturing sectors.

She added that the government is committed to reinforcing MSMEs as the backbone of the national economy by prioritising the involvement of women entrepreneurs, in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal on gender equality.

"Various initiatives have

been implemented, including entrepreneurial training, digital skills development, and improved access to financing and markets.

"The National Entrepreneurship Policy 2030 also ensures equal opportunities for women to enter the entrepreneurial field, which holds immense potential as a career choice. Moreover, the contribution of MSMEs to the nation's economy has shown consistent growth annually," she

said at the graduation ceremony for the IDEAS Project, here yesterday.

On the IDEAS Project, Noor Afifah said the programme is an Asean initiative in collaboration with South Korea, aimed at enhancing digital skills among women entrepreneurs in MSMEs.

"Nearly 3,000 women MSME entrepreneurs from across Asean have participated in this programme, including 242

from Malaysia. This six-month programme has provided immense benefits through its structured training modules," she said.

She further shared that the South Korea plans to invite project participants to an entrepreneurship expo in the country by 2026.

"Kuskop is confident that the IDEAS Project will empower more women entrepreneurs in MSMEs to expand their business

potential using digital tools and e-commerce platforms more effectively.

"Many entrepreneurs are already leveraging digital platforms like Lazada, Shopee, TikTok and Instagram to broaden their customer base," she added.

Noor Afifah also highlighted that a structured transition to digital platforms would enable entrepreneurs to reach customers not just within Malaysia but also across Asean. — Bernama

Reformasi pendidikan seksual 'senjata' cegah isu sosial remaja

- Menurut Pertubuhan Kesihatan Sedunia (WHO), negara melaksanakan pendidikan seksual komprehensif mencatatkan penurunan ketara dalam kadar kehamilan remaja

- Dengan memberikan remaja dan belia pengetahuan tepat dan relevan, mereka dapat membuat keputusan bijak mengenai kesihatan seksual serta reproduktif, mengurangkan tingkah laku seksual berisiko

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Pendidikan seksual adalah aspek penting dalam perkembangan remaja dan belia, terutama dalam masyarakat moden semakin kompleks.

Dengan kemudahan akses kepada media sosial dan maklumat tidak terkawal, remaja sering terdedah kepada maklumat salah atau tidak tepat mengenai seksualiti.

Oleh itu, pendidikan seksual berstruktur dan komprehensif sangat penting untuk mencegah masalah sosial seperti kehamilan luar nikah remaja dan penularan penyakit kelamin.

Dalam hal ini, pendidikan seksual di Malaysia masih menjadi topik sensitif dan sering mendapat reaksi bercampur-baur.

Program seperti Pendidikan Kesihatan Reproduksi dan Sosial (PEERS) juga diperkenalkan, namun cabaran budaya, agama dan stigma masyarakat terhadap isu seksualiti masih menghalang keberkesanan program ini.

Kajian menunjukkan pendidikan seksual disampaikan secara formal dapat membantu mengurangkan kadar kehamilan remaja. Menurut Pertubuhan Kesihatan Sedunia (WHO), negara melaksanakan pendidikan seksual komprehensif mencatatkan penurunan ketara dalam kadar kehamilan remaja.

Sebagai contoh, Belanda yang mempunyai salah satu program pendidikan seksual paling maju, mencatatkan kadar kehamilan remaja rendah iaitu hanya empat kehamilan bagi setiap 1,000 remaja perempuan berumur 15-19 tahun.

Program di Belanda menekankan aspek biologi, emosi dan tanggungjawab sosial dalam hubungan seksual, sekali gus membantu remaja membuat keputusan bijak.

Di Filipina, pengenalan pendidikan seksual lebih terbuka membawa kepada pengurangan kadar kehamilan remaja sebanyak 15 peratus dalam tempoh tiga tahun selepas pelaksanaan program itu pada 2000. Negara itu juga memberi latihan intensif kepada guru untuk menyampaikan topik sensitif secara efektif.

Ketiadaan pendidikan seksual atau program tidak mencukupi boleh membawa kesan buruk. Di Malaysia, pendidikan seksual dimasukkan dalam kurikulum melalui subjek Pendidikan Jasmani dan Pendidikan Moral dengan fokus kepada kesihatan reproduktif, perubahan fizikal remaja dan pencegahan penyakit kelamin.

Namun, pendekatan ini terlalu umum dan tidak menyentuh aspek penting seperti hubungan sihat, persetujuan dan hak seksual.

Menurut laporan Tabung Kanak-Kanak Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu (UNICEF) 2021, sebahagian besar pelajar di Malaysia tidak mendapat pendidikan seksual komprehensif dengan 48 peratus daripada mereka berasa kurang bersedia menangani isu seksualiti.

Laporan sama menyatakan 35 peratus remaja perempuan dan 22 peratus remaja lelaki tidak memahami kaedah kontrasepsi asas.

Kajian Kementerian Kesihatan (KKM) pada 2020 menunjukkan hampir 18,000 kes kehamilan remaja, dengan 25 peratus daripadanya bawah 18 tahun.

Lebih membimbangkan, kajian Universiti Malaysia pada 2019 mendapati hanya 40 peratus pelajar sekolah menengah memahami dengan jelas kaedah perlindungan seperti kondom dan pil perancang. Ini mendedahkan remaja kepada risiko penyakit kelamin seperti HIV dan gonorea.

Kajian menunjukkan pendidikan seksual disampaikan secara formal dapat membantu mengurangkan kadar kehamilan remaja

Laporan KKM juga mencatatkan 44,263 kes kehamilan remaja direkodkan dalam lima tahun terakhir dengan 17,646 daripadanya belum berkahwin.

Data ini menunjukkan peningkatan dalam kalangan remaja yang aktif secara seksual tanpa pengetahuan mencukupi mengenai perlindungan dan akibatnya. Kekurangan pengetahuan ini membawa kepada amalan seks tidak selamat berisiko tinggi.

Antara faktor penyumbang adalah kekurangan latihan khusus kepada guru menyampaikan pendidikan seksual.

62 peratus guru tak yakin ajar topik seksualiti
Kajian UM pada 2020 mendapati 62 peratus guru berasa tidak yakin mengajar topik seksualiti kerana takut menyinggung sensitiviti pelajar atau ibu bapa.

Kandungan pendidikan seksual dalam kurikulum sekolah di Malaysia juga masih terhad dan tidak menyeluruh. Topik seperti persetujuan dalam hubungan, kehamilan tidak diingini dan kesan emosi akibat hubungan seksual jarang dibincangkan secara mendalam.

Pendidikan seksual komprehensif terbukti berke-

san mengurangkan tingkah laku seksual berisiko.

Sebagai contoh, program intervensi pencegahan tingkah laku seks bebas dan kehamilan remaja di Kanada berjaya mengurangkan tingkah laku seksual berisiko dengan kadar jangkitan penyakit kelamin dalam kalangan remaja menurun 15 peratus tempoh lima tahun.

Program ini mengutamakan sains, keseksamaan gender, hubungan sihat, persetujuan dan hak tubuh badan, membuktikan pendidikan seksual bukan sahaja mengurangkan kehamilan tetapi mengurangkan stigma terhadap penyakit kelamin.

Di Malaysia, keberkesanan pendidikan seksual dapat ditingkatkan dengan pendekatan lebih komprehensif dan sensitif terhadap budaya. Ini termasuk membabitkan ibu bapa dalam proses pendidikan, menyediakan latihan khusus kepada guru dan memastikan maklumat disampaikan tepat serta relevan dengan konteks semasa.

Kajian Universiti Putra Malaysia menunjukkan hubungan erat ibu bapa dan anak memainkan peranan penting dalam penyampaian maklumat pendidikan seksual.

Selain itu, intervensi membabitkan komuniti dan rakan sebaya juga boleh membantu menyebarkan maklumat betul mengenai kesihatan seksual. Berakna, reformasi pendidikan seksual di Malaysia amat penting bagi memenuhi keperluan generasi muda.

Pendidikan seksual adalah alat penting membimbing remaja dan belia memahami tanggungjawab mereka terhadap diri sendiri serta masyarakat, sekali gus mencegah isu sosial seperti kehamilan usia remaja dan penularan penyakit kelamin.

Pendekatan lebih holistik dan sensitif terhadap budaya perlu diterapkan untuk memastikan keberkesanan program ini. Selain itu, pelaburan dalam pendidikan seksual berkualiti bukan sahaja penting untuk kesihatan generasi muda tetapi untuk kestabilan sosial negara secara keseluruhan.

Dengan memberikan remaja dan belia pengetahuan tepat dan relevan, mereka dapat membuat keputusan bijak mengenai kesihatan seksual serta reproduktif, mengurangkan tingkah laku seksual berisiko.

Pendidikan seksual komprehensif dan berkesan adalah penting dalam mencegah kehamilan remaja serta penularan penyakit kelamin. Reformasi pendidikan seksual perlu dilakukan untuk memastikan ia dapat memenuhi keperluan generasi muda.

Melalui usaha ini, generasi akan datang diharapkan dapat membuat keputusan lebih bertanggungjawab mengenai kesihatan seksual dan membentuk masyarakat lebih sihat dan bertanggungjawab.

RELIEF AS FLOODS EASE UP IN JOHOR

Slight improvement to situation as the number of evacuees dips to 3,118 at 35 relief centres

JASMINE SHADIQ
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THE flood situation in Johor improved slightly, recording 3,118 victims housed at 35 relief centres yesterday evening.

This was a drop from the 3,973 victims who had sought shelter at 38 temporary relief centres across five districts in the state, following heavy rain the previous night.

However, Johor Disaster Management Committee chairman Tan Sri Dr Azmi Rohani said based on the hourly statistics, the number of evacuees surged before going down.

Four districts were affected, with Kota Tinggi remaining the hardest hit district given its low-lying location.

There are 1,251 victims from 366

families housed in 15 centres.

In **Johor Baru**, 708 evacuees from 189 families were in five centres, Pontian had 625 victims from 176 families in 10 centres, while Kluang had 536 evacuees in five centres.

Sungai Kahang in Kluang remains at a dangerous level, while Sungai Lenik in Batu Pahat and Sungai Skudai at Kampung Pasir recorded alert level warnings.

Sungai Muar in Segamat, Sungai Skudai at Kampung Laut,

Simpang Kiri in Batu Pahat, Sungai Benut in Pontian, and Sungai Johor along with its tributaries are being monitored and are on the alert level.

The Malaysian Meteorological Department (MetMalaysia) fore-

casted thunderstorms in all 10 districts in Johor for the whole day, although it stopped raining about 2pm yesterday.

MetMalaysia also warned of a second wave of continuous rain from Jan 15 to 18.

Flood leaves over 30 m-cycles damaged in Skudai

JOHOR BARU: More than 30 motorcycles were damaged when floodwaters inundated a motorcycle workshop in Kampung Sepakat Baru, Skudai, early on Sunday.

Workshop owner Muhamad Aminuddin Nordin, 32, said they only managed to salvage 10 of the 30 motorcycles before the floodwaters surged.

"The water rose rapidly and was waist-deep by 8am.

"My own car and motorcycles were submerged, and workshop items like motorcycle seat covers were swept away, while tools and equipment were left buried in mud," said Aminuddin, who has operated the business with his younger brother Borhanuddin for 12 years.

The floodwaters began rising around 4am while the family was asleep, leaving them with little time to react. Many customers' motorcycles and electronics parts were affected.

However, Aminuddin expressed gratitude that his family was safe as they had evacuated to the relief centre at Dewan Muafakat Majlis Bandaraya Iskandar Puteri.

His father, Nordin Taib, 64, who suffers from severe diabetes and limited mobility, was evacuated by Fire and Rescue Department personnel.

Aminuddin's pregnant wife, Fatim Syahirah Roslan, 31, and their 3-year-old daughter were also given priority during the evacuation.

Although the floodwaters receded quickly, the damage was extensive, with estimated losses exceeding RM20,000.

"This flood wasn't as severe as the one in 2007, but it was sudden.

"Some customers understand this was an unforeseen natural disaster, but if anyone demands

compensation, I'll do my best to address it."

Despite the challenges, Aminuddin remains optimistic.

"It's overwhelming to think about everything, but I trust Allah's plan. Stressing over it won't help," he added, as he surveyed the extensive damage to his workshop.

140 evacuated as tidal flooding hits 3 villages

ROMPIN: Tidal flooding hit three low-lying villages in Kuala Rompin and led to the evacuation of 37 families on Sunday.

The Rompin District Disaster Management Committee said in a statement that the families, comprising 140 people, were relocated to Balairaya Kampung Jawa at 9.30pm.

"The high tide, along with strong winds, caused seawater to overflow at three villages — Kampung Pantai 3, Kampung Pantai and Kampung Jawa. Several homes at the three settlements were inundated.

"The Kampung Jawa village headman alerted authorities to the incident which forced 140 people, including 38 children, to be temporarily moved to the relief centre.

"The Civil Defence Force provided meals to the victims while the Welfare Department provided other assistance," read the statement.

Selangor, Terengganu most at risk

254 critical slopes identified nationwide

PETALING JAYA: Selangor and Terengganu continue to be put under a "slope watch" for possible landslides, with both having seen an increase in the number of high-risk slopes in the past year.

Statistics showed that while most states saw a reduction in the number of high-risk slopes, both these states registered an increase.

Selangor now has 15 high-risk slopes, up by one, while Terengganu's increased by two, bringing its total to 12.

Mineral and Geoscience Department director-general Datuk Zamri Ramli said 254 critical slopes were identified throughout the country last year, with 86 categorised as high risk, 84 medium risk and 84 low risk.

High-risk slopes demand immediate mitigation and restoration efforts, with maintenance needed every four months.

Moderate-risk slopes should undergo restoration promptly with maintenance every six months, while low-risk slopes needed monitoring every 18 months.

Zamri said the number of critical slopes nationwide was the same as 2023, while the number of high- and medium-risk slopes fell by 17.3% and 13.4% respectively.

Sabah has the most critical slopes at 36, followed by Johor, Kelantan, Pahang, Terengganu, and Perak, each with 25. Sarawak has 21, Negri Sembilan (19), Penang (14), Kedah (seven), Melaka (six), Perlis (four), and the Federal Territories (two).

Zamri said cracks in walls or floors, blocked drains and tilting utility poles or fences were early warning signs of a landslide, adding that people living near slopes needed to be wary of this.

Other signs included water seeping from slopes or pooling at the base of slopes, and visible cracks along the surface.

"Residents living near slopes should remain vigilant for these early warning signs of landslides, especially during downpours," he told *The Star*.

Parts of the country are currently experiencing heavy rain during the current northeast

monsoon, raising the risk of landslides, especially at high-risk slopes.

The department identified 31 landslide hotspots nationwide last year using data from the National Geospatial Terrain and Slope Information System (NaTISIS).

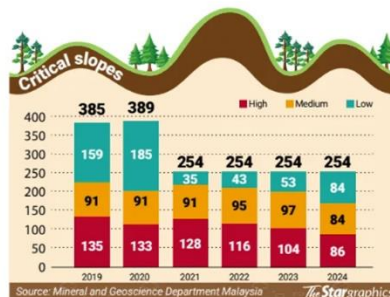
Seventy-four landslides were recorded last year.

"The department gathers up-to-date information by periodically monitoring the identified critical slopes through field observations, including drone surveillance.

"The results of these monitoring activities are communicated to response agencies such as the National Disaster Management Agency, Fire and Rescue Department and other relevant technical departments," Zamri said.

He said four community-based disaster risk management programmes were conducted last year to raise the awareness of folk living in landslide-prone areas on the possible dangers they faced.

"Monitoring equipment has been set up at 28 critical slope

locations to strengthen early warning systems.

"These include movement sensors, rain gauges, CCTV cameras and sirens," said Zamri, adding that these measures are aimed at enhancing community preparedness and reducing the risk to lives and property.

The DG said early signs of landslides can be reported to local authorities or relevant agencies

such as the Public Works Department, Irrigation and Drainage Department and Forestry Department.

"We will provide geological input to the relevant agencies through on-site assessments and recommend appropriate solutions. With community vigilance and robust monitoring systems, we can minimise the risk and impact of landslides," he added.

Disaster risk higher as it gets wetter

PETALING JAYA: Landslides happen because of a variety of factors that could affect the ground's stability, according to an expert.

Universiti Teknologi Malaysia deputy vice-chancellor (development) Prof Dr Eddy Tonnizian Mohamad said landslides occur when the force of gravity exceeds the equilibrium.

"This refers to forces that affect stability, including volume, friction angle, plasticity, liquidity and many other parameters.

"Rain could increase water pressure in soil, reducing stability and increasing the probability of slides," he said when contacted.

Apart from landslide risks during wet weather conditions, he said there is also the risk of groundwater levels increasing, as well as floods.

Groundwater refers to water found in cracks and spaces in soil, sand and rock.

"This could result in low lying areas being more prone to floods," he said.

Meanwhile, an international weather centre said La Nina conditions are already present. La Nina typically brings about wetter weather conditions.

In an advisory uploaded on Jan 9, the Climate Prediction Centre said La Nina conditions are expected to persist until April this year.

Climatologist Prof Datuk Dr Azizan Abu Samah said Malaysia could expect between 10% and 20% more rain during La Nina.

"Since we are at the tail end of the northeast monsoon, the risk of floods has decreased for Malaysia as the monsoon trough is already located south.

"With La Nina, we also have strengthening easterly winds and can expect the southwest monsoon to onset later than usual,"

he said.

Azizan, who is a senior research fellow at Universiti Malaya's Institute of Ocean and Earth Sciences, said with La Nina, it could bring about more rain during the southwest monsoon season.

The southwest monsoon, which is a typically drier season for the country, usually begins in early May and lasts until September before transitioning to the inter-monsoon period.

"Also, increased coastal erosion could be expected due to higher

and stronger waves due to above average easterly winds associated with the La Nina," he said.

The previous La Nina episode was in 2020 and ended in early 2023. It was supposed to only last a year.

During that episode, the Klang Valley experienced major flooding in December 2021.

Three days of continuous downpour in the third week of that month inundated much of the Klang Valley, leading to 48 deaths.

In addition, thousands of peo-

ple were evacuated with houses and furniture damaged in several districts in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and parts of Pahang.

In March 2022, flash floods hit the Klang Valley, paralysing parts of Kuala Lumpur and inundating various roads and highways.

Baling in Kedah also experienced major floods in July 2022, displacing hundreds of people.

A landslide occurred on the main road in Kampung Raja near the Blue Valley junction in Cameron Highlands, blocking routes from Simpang Pulai/Lojing to Cameron Highlands in both directions.

Nov 4, 2024

A landslide occurred in Lembah Maju, Pandan Indah, resulting in a car plunging off the collapsed cliff.

Oct 15, 2024

A landslide in Taman Melawati, Selangor, saw the authorities ordering the evacuation of residents from some 20 terrace houses.

Sept 2, 2024

A landslide occurred at Brinchang in Cameron Highlands with no casualties reported.

April 25, 2023

A landslide occurred at the entrance to the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Academy in Kuala Lumpur, destroying the guard post there.

Dec 16, 2022

A landslide struck the Father's Organic Farm campsite along the Batang Kali-Genting stretch in the wee hours of the morning. There were 31 deaths, while 61 people were rescued.

Ministry mobilises resources to aid flood victims

KUCHING: The Ministry of Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development has intensified efforts to support those affected by floods by ensuring they receive essential aid.

Minister Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah said such efforts focused on timely food supply distribution and overall wellbeing.

"Our primary focus is to ensure the timely provision of basic food supplies and support to affected individuals, whether they are relocated to any of the 661 evacuation centres (PPS), or those remaining in their longhouses who, although they are not affected, but communication is cut off by floodwaters.

"For flood victims who are evacuated to the PPS, the state

Welfare Department ensures that the flood victims are served with cooked food," she said in a statement yesterday.

Fatimah said for those in remote villages and longhouses or those with no road facilities, the ministry has established 27 forward bases in strategic locations.

"These bases enable us to distribute dry food supplies quickly and efficiently, ensuring that no family goes without food during this critical time," she added.

In addition to food and shelter, she said the ministry prioritises the physical and mental wellbeing of flood victims.

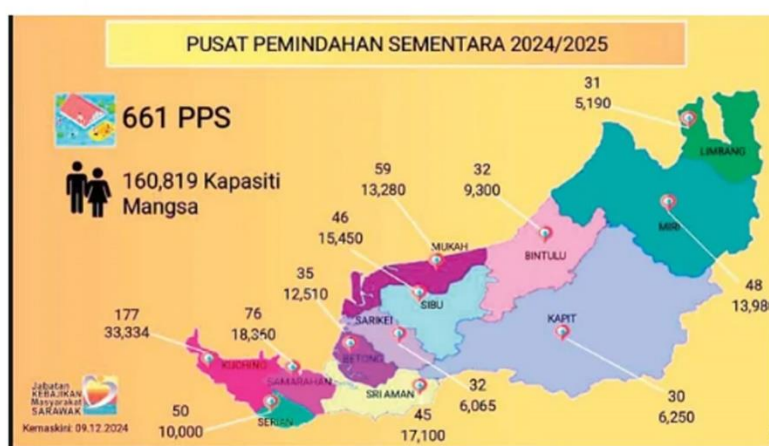
She said the Welfare Department, in collaboration with agencies such as the Civil Defence Force and Health

Department, provides a safe and supportive environment in the PPS, with special attention given to vulnerable groups, including children and the elderly, with efforts to address their emotional and psychological needs.

She advised parents not to allow their children to play in floodwaters due to the risks posed by strong currents, debris, and waterborne diseases.

She also stressed the importance of adhering to evacuation orders and guidance from local disaster management committees to ensure safety and facilitate the work of emergency responders.

"We urge the public to stay vigilant during the monsoon season and to report any urgent needs in their respective areas to the authorities," she added.

Tertuduh yang berusia 67 tahun mengaku tidak bersalah sejurus pertuduhan dibacakan di hadapan Hakim Syazana Abd. Lajis.

Mahkamah membenarkan tertuduh diikat jamin RM8,000 beserta syarat tambahan dilarang mengganggu mangsa dan saksi pendakwaan, melapor diri di balai polis berhampiran sebulan sekali serta pasport diserahkan kepada mahkamah jika ada.

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Rogol adik kandung: Nelayan dihukum penjara 40 tahun, 40 sebatan

KUALA TERENGGANU: Seorang nelayan dijatuhi hukuman penjara 40 tahun dan 40 sebatan selepas mengaku bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen Kuala Terengganu hari ini atas empat pertuduhan merogol adik kandungnya sendiri.

Hakim Mohd Zul Zakiquudin Zulkifli menjatuhkan hukuman itu terhadap tertuduh yang berusia 30 tahun selepas pertuduhan dibacakan mengikut Seksyen 376(1) Kanun Keseksaan.

Menurut pertuduhan, tertuduh yang masih bujang didakwa melakukan perbuatan terkutuk itu berulang kali terhadap mangsa yang berusia 24 tahun, di sebuah rumah di Seberang Takir, Kuala Nerus, Terengganu, antara Oktober hingga Disember tahun lalu.

Kejadian berlaku ketika ahli keluarga lain tiada di rumah.

Mahkamah menjatuhkan hukuman penjara selama 10 tahun dan 10 sebatan bagi setiap pertuduhan, dengan hukuman penjara dijalankan serentak bermula dari tarikh tangkapan pada 4 Januari lalu.

Tertuduh akan menjalani hukuman 24 sebatan berdasarkan had maksimum yang dibenarkan mengikut Seksyen 288 Kanun Prosedur.

Labourer charged with raping 15-year-old

KOTA BARU: A labourer was charged here yesterday with raping and engaging in sexual communication via video call with a 15-year-old girl in December last year.

Muhammad Amir Zikrillah Mohd Nor pleaded not guilty after the charges were read out to him before Sessions Court judge Zulkifli Abllah.

The accused is alleged to have engaged in sexual communication via video call with a 15-year-old girl in Kampung Pulau Pisang, Jalan Kuala Besar, at 8pm on Dec 29.

If convicted, the accused faces up to three years in prison.

Amir is also charged with raping the same teenager at the same location at 12.10am on Dec 30.

If convicted, he faces up to 20 years in jail and whipping.

The prosecution was conducted by deputy public prosecutor Ahmad Faiz Fitri Mohamad, while the accused was not represented.

The court set bail at RM12,000 with one surety and fixed Feb 13 for the case mention.
